CHECK IN

Welcome! We're looking forward to hosting your stay in St. Pete. Parking in front of the home along the road is free. Ensure you're parked on the right side of the road, facing the right direction. We'll message you the code to the front door prior to your stay. Just pull the door closed and turn the lock. Everything within the home is ready for your stay. The backdoor is a bit sticky, so it needs to be closed with some oomph. Please only lock the deadbolt - NOT the handle. Check-in is anytime after 1PM.

CHECKOUT

Checkout is before 11AM. Prior to checkout we just ask that you take out the trash and recycling. The gate in the back of the home provides quick and easy access to the alley where there are large black bins for trash and blue bins for recycling. Also, please do not leave dishes in the sink and run the dishwasher if there are any dirty items.

Please ensure the home looks similar to how it did when you arrived.

CANCELLATIONS

We currently have a moderate refund policy which allows guests to receive a full refund as long as they cancel 5 days prior to arrival. In addition to moderate, we also offer a non-refundable option with 10% savings.

GETTING AROUND

If you're bringing a vehicle, there's free street parking in front of the home. Ride sharing apps like Uber and Lyft operate in the area. You have plenty of options, however, the best part of staying here, is the walkability of the neighborhood and the proximity to Central Ave. Here, you can also hop on electric scooters from Veo and Razor and ride downtown to the pier in less than 15 minutes

BEACH TRANSPORTATION

In Summer 2022, the SunRunner will begin operation along 1st Ave. This service will connect the city to the beach with quick and easy rides every 15 to 30 minutes. Get to the beach faster, cheaper, and without the need to search for parking.

CROSS BAY TRANSPORT

If you're looking to venture over to Tampa for the day - checkout the Cross Bay Ferry schedule. This service operates October through May, but is expected to operate year-round by 2024
