

Parking

Parking along 8th Ave is free 2 hour parking from 8AM to 6PM, Pass-a-Grille has street parking available along Gulf Way, 9th Ave, 15th Ave and 16th Ave starting at \$3.25 an hour or \$50 for 12 hours. You can use card or the ParkMobile App. Pass-A-Grille Beach Community Church also has parking available for a cash donation (see red mailbox.)

How do I get from the Ceremony to the Reception?

The ceremony will be held at the 17th Ave Beach Access point on Pass-a-Grille. From here, it's approximately 0.5 miles to the Berkeley Beach Club on 8th Ave. Walking along the beach, or along the boardwalk on Gulf Way will take approximately 10 minutes. Starting at 4PM, we'll have 2 golf carts available to drive groups of 5 to the Berkeley Beach Club.

What should I do between the ceremony and reception?

Guests are welcome to attend an unofficial, poolside cocktail hour at La Tortuga, located across the street from the reception venue. If you're staying nearby you can swing by your hotel, or you can visit local dive bar - Shaddrack's.

Transportation

<u>Sun Runner:</u> Fast, affordable and convenient with limited stops from St. Pete Beach to Downtown.

- Download the Transit App or visit the <u>PSTA Trip Planner</u>; enter your starting location and destination to plan your trip.
- Wait at your selected SunRunner stop.
- The totem sign at each SunRunner station will display real-time information about when the next bus will arrive.
- SunRunner buses will arrive every 15 minutes from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. and every 30 minutes from 8 p.m. to midnight Sunday-Saturday.

<u>Freebee shuttle</u>: a free, door-to-door, on-demand transportation service for St. Pete Beach.

- Download the app to request free on demand rides.
- Freebee vehicles are 100% electric, and emission-free!
- Freebee provides booster seats as appropriate for children who exceed the size requirements to travel in a car seat.
- Smaller children and infants are required to be secured in a federally approved car seat, provided by their parent or guardian.
- Rides can also be requested by flagging down an available Freebee!
